The cost is \$5 per Player for all Divisions. Players must be PFA licensed and be Victorian residents

All Players must pre-Qualify at the Club level with point scores as follows: Men 30+, Women 25+, Juniors 15+

Registrations on MyPetanque close at midnight on Friday 4 February 2022. Players may also register on the day of the event

Event played to PFA Rules and Regulations

Conditions of Play

Each shooter must carry out a complete series of 20 throws; 1 throw each at 6m, 7m, 8m and 9m for 5 separate targets. A total elapsed time of 15 minutes is allowed. After the Qualifying Round, the Semi-Finals, in each Division, will comprise 1st versus 4th and 2nd versus 3rd playing side-by-side. For the State Final in each Division the two contenders also play side-by-side. There will also be a play-off to determine 3rd and 4th positions (subject to numbers). 1 State Player only, in each Division, who meets the above qualifying point scores may register for the Finals at the 2022 PFA Easter Carnival at Novar Gardens.

Awards

There will be no monetary prizes. The winners in each Division will receive a medallion
