Committee Meeting 21 May 2025 at 9:30am at the Clubhouse

1. Welcome

Coleen welcomed all to the meeting.

2. Apologies Bob Hutchinson

3. Confirmation of minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed.

4. Child Safe Policy

The committee endorsed the draft Child Safe Policy prepared by Deidre based on the VicSport template, subject to some minor changes. Deidre gave a brief background to the Child Safe legislation in Victoria. The club received advice in 2022 from the Commission for Children and Young People that we did not fall within the scheme. Boroondara Council recently advised they expect us to have a policy before we next apply for sports club accreditation.

Deidre will review the club's Code of Conduct to include references to the child safe policy and recent discussions about respect for openers.

Coleen will promote the Code of Conduct and Child Safe Policy with links to the CPC website.

5. Committee calendar

The finalised calendar was noted and will be used to plan committee agendas.

6. Friday night play

Coleen has received six emails in response to the request for feedback on the proposal to suspend organised Friday night play over winter. It was decided to maintain organised play during winter with two games subject to there being enough openers.

The committee noted the existing policy that an opener always attends unless one the two conditions of inclement weather are met – over 35deg or pistes are flooded.

Agreed to nominate Guy Mercier in the Community Athlete of the Year category for the Boroondara Sports Awards. Deidre to submit the nomination.
