About the game

Petanque (p'tonk) is a target sport in the same family as bocce and lawn bowls. The object of the game is to score points by getting your boule closer to the jack than your opponent.

Unlike bocce or bowling, boules are metal and are not rolled on the ground, but tossed in the air with a little arc and sometimes some backspin.

Each game lasts about an hour and is always played between two teams.

The game originated in the south of France and is played all over the world, including here in leafy Camberwell.



Why it's so good

It can be played by any age, any fitness level, men and women play together.

Teams are drawn randomly every game so you don't have to be part of a fixed team.

We play three times a week so you can choose when you play.

It doesn't require expensive equipment, all you need is a set of boules and a jack.

It's informal there are no uniforms and not a lot of rules.

It's quick and easy to learn.

And it's social

Our weekly social games are drawn at random so you mix with everyone.

There's time to sit, chat and have a quick meal before playing.

We have card afternoons, Cup Day play, a mid year dinner and a fabulous Christmas celebration.
