

## *Major points from the Committee Meeting 26<sup>th</sup> October 2019*

CPC's 21<sup>st</sup> birthday party was a great success, with 48 members and a total of 90 attendees. The Club members assisted with the excellent catering which was most appreciated.

Grants: The Club needs to keep up to date with available Council, Kooyong Electorate, State and Federal Government grants and what activities or improvements the Club could apply for.

Lighting Proposal: A final revision of the proposal will be done and sent to the Grant contact in the next week. Installation requires only a couple of weeks once we obtain the funds and let the contract. We will ask the contractor to visit the Club before Xmas to discuss details. We are within the Club budget for the project of \$49,660.00. The Committee approved the project to proceed.

The Minutes of the Joint Management Committee have been requested on previous occasions and again at their most recent meeting, these are of interest to our Club and this needs to be chased up.

Piste Drainage: It was noted that geo fabric material had been laid under the top surface by the bowling club but was not thought to be a major cause of the pooling of water. The bitumen layer may be a more likely cause. Agreed we need some research, accompanied by expert opinion before taking any action.

Weed Control: Ask Michael of Barry's Mowing to spray asap.

Surf & Turf: The tournament between CPC and St Andrews is set for 23<sup>rd</sup> November at St Andrews. We need to know how many players they have so as we can match up teams.

Happy Hour: To commence on 2<sup>nd</sup> November and be held monthly.
